**Musicians from the New York Philharmonic To Perform Works by
Bernard Andrès, Reinecke, and Dvořák**

The New York Philharmonic Ensembles, composed of Musicians from the Orchestra, will begin its 2010–11 season on Sunday, October 10, 2010, at 3:00 p.m. at Merkin Concert Hall with a program that features Bernard Andrès's *Chants d'arrière-saison*, Reinecke's Sextet, and Dvořák's Quintet for Piano and Strings in A major, Op. 81.

The musicians will be Michelle Kim and Hae-Young Ham, violin; Robert Rinehart, viola; Ru-Pei Yeh, cello; Nancy Allen, harp; Mindy Kaufman, flute; Robert Botti, oboe; Pascual Martinez Forteza, clarinet; Judith LeClair and Kim Laskowski, bassoon; Philip Myers and R. Allen Spanjer, horn; and Eric Huebner, piano.*

Since 1984 the Philharmonic Ensembles series has presented diverse programming of both classical masterpieces and modern compositions. Ensembles concerts are also offered on the Orchestra's international and domestic tours, on separate chamber music tours, and at locations throughout New York City.
