NEW YORK PHILHARMONIC ENSEMBLES AT MERKIN CONCERT HALL

2010–11 Season To Feature Works Ranging from Bach and Beethoven to Britten, Bridge, and by Philharmonic Musicians

The New York Philharmonic Ensembles, composed of Musicians from the Orchestra, will again present its popular chamber music series in the 2010–11 season at Merkin Concert Hall. The series will feature works ranging from Bach, Beethoven, and Brahms, to Britten, Bridge, and works by two Philharmonic musicians — bassist David J. Grossman and violinist Vladimir Tsy-pin. The programs, which are performed on Sundays at 3:00 p.m., will take place October 10, 2010; December 12, 2010; January 16, 2011; February 27, 2011; March 27, 2011; and June 12, 2011.

Since 1984 the Philharmonic Ensembles series has presented diverse programming of both classical masterpieces and modern compositions. Ensembles concerts are also offered on the orchestra's international and domestic tours, on separate chamber music tours, and at locations throughout New York City.
