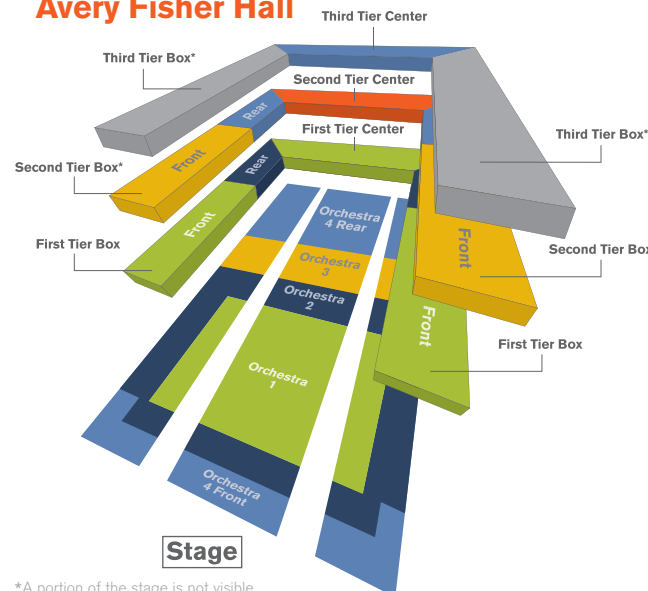

## Avery Fisher Hall at Lincoln Center

### Broadway and 65th Street

Unless otherwise noted, all concerts are held at Avery Fisher Hall, Lincoln Center, located on Broadway and 65th Street.

#### Directions to Lincoln Center

##### By Subway

Take the No.1 local train to the 66th Street/Lincoln Center Station.

##### By Bus

The M5, M7, M10, M11, M66, and M104 bus lines all stop within one block of Lincoln Center.

##### By Car

**From Long Island:** Long Island Expressway to Midtown Tunnel; go cross-town to 8th Avenue. Then north to 62nd–65th Street.

##### From New Jersey

##### Lincoln Tunnel

Take the left exit towards 40th Street and North. Turn left onto West 42nd Street, right onto 10th Avenue, continuing to 65th Street.

##### Holland Tunnel

Follow signs to Exit 1 into Laight Street. Follow Laight Street to West Side Highway to 56th Street. Right onto West 56th Street, left onto 11th Avenue. Right on West 65th Street. Lincoln Center Garage is between Amsterdam and Columbus.

##### George Washington Bridge/ I-95 North

Take the Henry Hudson Parkway/178th Street exit onto Henry Hudson Parkway South/West Side Highway. Take to West 79th Street exit and follow the circle, exit onto 79th street. Right onto West End Avenue, heading south. Left onto 65th Street. Lincoln Center Garage is between Amsterdam and Columbus.

##### From Upstate New York

##### Westchester/Saw Mill Parkway/ Henry Hudson Parkway South

Take to West Side Highway. Take to West 79th Street exit and follow the circle and exit onto 79th Street. Right onto West End Avenue, heading south. Left onto 65th Street. Lincoln Center Garage is between Amsterdam and Columbus Avenues.

#### From New York State Thruway

Take to Cross Bronx Expressway, taking the last Manhattan exit (leading towards George Washington Bridge). Follow Henry Hudson Parkway South. Take to West 79th Street exit and follow directions from Upstate New York. From Connecticut: Take I-95 South to Cross Bronx Expressway, taking the last Manhattan exit (leading towards George Washington Bridge). Follow Henry Hudson Parkway South. Take to West 79th Street exit and follow directions from Upstate New York.

##### Lincoln Center Park & Lock Garage
